ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT BENEFICIAL USE OF BY-PRODUCT MATERIALS REGISTRATION

Pursuant to the Solid Waste Disposal Act, Ala. Code. §§22-27-1, *et seq.*, and attendant regulations promulgated thereunder by the Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM), this registration is issued to Buford L Bryant Wastewater Treatment Plant (hereinafter called the Registrant), to operate the facility described above.

The Registrant must comply with all terms and conditions of this registration and the applicable regulations contained in [Chapters 335-13-1 through 335-13-16 of the ADEM Administrative Code \(referred to as the "ADEM Admin. Code" or "335-13"\)](#). Applicable ADEM Administrative Codes are those that are in effect on the date of issuance of this registration or the revisions approved after initial issuance.

This registration is based on the Registration Application submitted to ADEM on March 23, 2021. The application is hereby incorporated by reference and hereinafter referred to as the Application. Inaccuracies found in the Application could lead to the termination or modification of this registration and potential enforcement action. The Registrant must inform ADEM of deviations from or changes in the information in the Application that would affect the Registrant's ability to comply with the applicable ADEM Administrative Code or registration.

I. Effect of Registration

The Registrant can handle byproduct materials for the sole purpose of beneficial use land application in accordance with the conditions of this registration and [ADEM Admin. Code div. 335-13](#). Issuance of this registration does not convey property rights of any sort or an exclusive privilege, nor does it authorize the injury to persons or property, the invasion of other private rights, or the infringement of state or local laws or regulations. Except for actions brought under Ala. Code §§22-27-9 and 22-27-12, *et seq.*, compliance with the conditions of this registration shall be deemed to be compliance with applicable requirements in effect as of the date of issuance of this registration and future revisions.

II. Duty to Comply

The Registrant must comply with all conditions of this registration and [ADEM Admin. Code div. 335-13](#) regulations applicable to this facility. Noncompliance with the registration constitutes a violation of Ala. Code §§22-27-9 and 22-27-12, *et seq.*, and is grounds for enforcement action, registration suspension, revocation, modification, and/or denial of a registration renewal application.

III. Inspection and Entry

Upon presentation of credentials and other documents as may be required by law, the Registrant shall allow the employees of ADEM or their authorized representative to:

- a. Enter at reasonable times the Registrant's premises where the regulated facility or activity is located or conducted, or where records must be kept.



- b. Have access to and copy, at reasonable times, the records that must be kept.
- c. Inspect, at reasonable times, the facilities, equipment, practices, or operations regulated by this registration.

IV. Records to be maintained

The Registrant shall retain records, as required per [ADEM Admin. Code r. 335-13-16-04\(2\)](#) at the location specified in the Application and as shown below. Records of all data used to complete the Application for this registration for a period of at least three years from the date the record was created as per [ADEM Admin Code r. 335-13-16-06](#). This period may be extended by the request of ADEM at any time and are automatically extended during the course of an unresolved enforcement action regarding this facility.

V. Reporting

The Registrant shall submit a yearly report to ADEM, which summarizes activities for each year as required by [ADEM Admin. Code r. 335-13-16-06\(1\)\(a\)](#). Reports are to be submitted no later than February 28th each year.

VI. Renewal

The Registrant must renew their registration no later than February 28, annually, as required per [ADEM Admin. Code r. 335-13-16-06\(1\)\(a\)](#). The applicable fee for renewal must also be submitted before February 28, as required per [ADEM Admin. Code r. 335-1-6-06](#). Payments of fees should be electronically submitted via [ADEM's eGov portal](#).
