RE: Warning Letter (dated 01.8.2026)
NextEra Energy Pipeline Holdings (Lowman), Inc. – Lowman Compressor Station
Facility No. 101-0024

Dear Mr. Ailor:

NextEra Energy Pipeline Holdings (Lowman), Inc. received the Warning Letter dated January 8, 2026, regarding the late 40 CFR Part 60, Subpart OOOOa Annual Report to ADEM's Air Division Office. The report was due on December 22, 2025, and was submitted to the ADEM's Air Division Office until December 23, 2025.

The letter requested a response by February 9, 2026, for the three questions below.

1. Who is responsible for ensuring compliance with applicable State and Federal air pollution control rules and regulation at this facility?

Lowman Response: Rachel Trainer, Director of Environmental, Health, and Safety is responsible for environmental compliance for the Lowman Compressor Station.

2. Why was the Annual Report not submitted to the Department in a timely manner?

Lowman Response: Ms. Trainer's Team hired a new employee in September 2025, who is now responsible for completing this report. This new employee was receiving on-the-job-training by an outside consultant who was previously hired to prepare and submit the report in 2025. A lack of effective knowledge transfer caused the new employee to submit the report 1 day late. In addition, the new employee had not been assigned the task in Maximo, the company's software tracking system, and thus didn't receive an automated notification of the Report deadline to the State Agency.

3. What measures does NextEra plan to implement to ensure all future reports are submitted to the Air Division in a timely manner:

Lowman Response: NextEra is updating its software tracking program, Maximo, for the Lowman 40 CFR Part 60, Subpart OOOOa Annual Reporting task to include multiple employee notifications, including to Management when a task is not marked "complete" by the deadline date in the software tool. This will ensure that the automated email is directed to multiple people rather than one individual, to have redundancy in awareness of the Report due date, including an escalation to management, if task is not marked complete in the system by the deadline.
